How to Use Gift Card Balance

1. Apply Balance at Checkout

It's easy to use your Amazon gift card balance at checkout. Using it is as simple as redeeming it. Once you've redeemed a gift card, that amount is automatically stored in your account.

Then at checkout, the system will automatically use your available balance to pay for the eligible items before charging a different payment method for the rest. If your balance is \$25 and your total is \$20, we'll apply the whole balance.

You'll now have \$5 to spend on your next order! You can check your balance at any time by going to "Your Account" then gift cards, or clicking "Account & Lists." For your own peace of mind, the transactions section of your Balance Page displays everything — order IDs, serial numbers, the whole shebang.

2. Combine with Other Payment Methods

Note that Amazon does not allow you to pay with multiple credit cards. You'll be able to apply your \$10 gift card balance against a \$30 order. The balance of \$20 will be charged to your card.

It's very simple to save a Visa gift card as a payment method. Just load it to your account the same way you'd load a regular Visa card!

3. Redeem for Digital Purchases

Amazon gift cards are an excellent fit for digital content, such as Kindle eBooks, movies, or apps. To redeem, simply pay attention to your balance and make your purchase.

Digital orders are taken directly out of your current balance, so it's a super easy way to spend gift card balance on digital content!

Common Issues and Solutions

1. Resolve Invalid Gift Card Codes

The most frequent problem when redeeming Amazon gift cards is an invalid code message. This is possible for a few reasons. For example, maybe the code was just entered wrong. Proofread to avoid errors such as confusing characters that look alike, like "O" and "0" or "I" and "1."

A second potential reason might be that the gift card was bought for another area. If your card reads, "Cannot Be Loaded/Redeemed in This Region," you must redeem this card in the appropriate region. Ensure that you visit the region tied to your purchase.

The "Claim Code Locked" error can occur when you didn't purchase the card yourself. In this instance, contacting Hubble's customer service is a fast way to remedy the problem and handle it.

2. Fix Balance Not Updating

Or you redeem a gift card and suddenly your balance isn't showing up on your account. Sometimes this is because of a lag in processing or a tech error. Proceed by trying to refresh the Amazon page or logout and login of your account.
