Usage Limits for Single Accounts

Parental Control Settings Impact

Approval Process for Code Usage

The family manager will need to log in to their account and approve the redemption through the PlayStation Store. It's just as important to note that codes are restricted to the original region of the account set up. If a code was bought for another region, it's not going to work.

To avoid disappointment, ensure you have the correct PlayStation Store region selected.

Limitations on Child Account Purchases

Free codes come with additional limitations with child accounts. Discount codes, for instance, are often not stackable with subscriptions, pre-orders or other discounts. They are not valid until you reach checkout, when they can be applied to the shopping cart.

If you encounter any problems, signing out and back into PSN can refresh the account. Additionally, verifying the Library and Recent Transaction history confirm proper redemption.
