Minimum Requirements to Run FiveM: A legal copy of GTA V

At least 8 GB RAM (16 GB recommended for smoother gameplay)

A mid-range GPU (GTX 1050 Ti or better)

Stable internet connection

Windows 10 or 11 (64-bit)

How to Install and Play FiveM:

Download FiveM:

Visit fivem.net and download the latest client.

Run Installer:

Install it on the same drive where GTA V is installed.

Launch FiveM:

Log in with your Cfx.re account. You'll now see the server browser.

Join a Server:

Use filters or the search bar to find servers (like "Roleplay", "Drift", "India RP", etc.)

Enjoy Custom GTA Worlds!

Follow server rules, create your character, and immerse yourself in the gameplay.

Want to Create Your Own FiveM Server?

If you're interested in running your own FiveM server (public or private), it's completely free.

Here's a quick overview:

Download the server artifacts from FiveM's official site.

Generate a license key from keymaster.fivem.net.

Configure your server.cfg file with basic settings.

Add custom resources, jobs, maps, and scripts.

Open port 30120 on your router to make it public.

You can build your server using ESX, QBCore, or other frameworks depending on your needs.
